Video responses must be uploaded to a Vimeo or YouTube account and the link submitted with your application.
- Images - Provide a visual response to the questions (x1 visual per question). Visual responses could be mind maps, photographs, collage, paintings, drawings, diagrams, cartoons or any other creative response. You must provide a short caption explaining the relevance of visual response to the application question. Please take a photograph of your art work and send it across to us in JPEG, PDF or Word format with your application.
- Combination of all three - Mix and match the formats of your responses to questions (e.g. 2 questions via images, 1 question via text, 1 question via video)
